MSHA Annual Refresher Training  
Program of Instruction for 2009***

Refresher training for 2009 will contain the following subject areas and approximate timeframes as shown below. Current training plans must reflect this information and have the NYS DOL listed as the training provider.

Human Factors in Mining	0.50 hrs.
Accident Prevention	0.75 hrs.
Risk Assessment	0.50 hrs.
30 CFR Part 56 Regulations	0.50 hrs.
Electrical Safety	1.00 hrs.
Machine Guarding	0.50 hrs.
30 CFR Part 47 HazCom	0.50 hrs.
30 CFR Part 62 Hearing Conservation	0.50 hrs.
Health Hazards in Mining	0.50 hrs.
Mobile Equipment Safety	1.00 hrs.
Ground Controls	0.75 hrs.
Evaluation & Effectiveness	0.50 hrs.
Total Hours	7.50 hrs.

**Private sector** mine operations will receive **7.5 hours** of training. Each private sector mine employer must conduct at least **0.5 hours** of site specific training on the site specific hazards of each mine operation where an employee must work. There will be room on each certificate to document this training.

**Public employer** mine operations will receive 7.0 hours of training with only 0.75 hours of mobile equipment safety and only 0.25 of ground controls. Each public sector mine employers (town & county) must conduct at least **1.0 hours** of site specific training on the site specific hazards of each mine operation where an employee must work. There will be room on each certificate to document this training.
