WHEREAS:



5. The parties' stipulation of settlement provides that by executing the stipulation, the Petitioners withdraw the petition; and
6. Rule 65.15 provides that at any stage of a proceeding, a party may withdraw the petition with the Board's approval; and


7. The Board approves the petitioners' withdrawal of the petition.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:


This proceeding be, and the same hereby is, discontinued in accordance with the Board's Rules.
