WHEREAS:


1. Pursuant to Labor Law Section 101 and Part 66 of the Board's Rules of Procedure and Practice (Rules), on September 4, 2007, Petitioner filed a petition for review of three Orders to Comply with Labor Law article 6 (Orders) that Respondent Commissioner of Labor (Commissioner) issued on June 1, 2007 against Petitioner; and
2. Respondent filed an answer to the petition on September 24, 2008; and
3. The parties participated in a pre-hearing telephone conference held on behalf of the Board; and
4. On April 24, 2009, the parties filed a fully executed Stipulation of Settlement (Settlement); and
5. The parties' Settlement provides, in part, that the Petitioner withdraws the petition; and


6. Rule 65.15 provides that “[a]t any stage of a proceeding, a party may withdraw his petition . . . subject to the approval of the Board;” and
7. The Board approves the Petitioner’s withdrawal of the petition, finds that further review of the Orders is unnecessary, and that the proceeding should be discontinued.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:


The above proceeding be, and the same hereby is, discontinued in accordance with the Board’s Rules.
