JANUARY 1990 - SEPTEMBER 2008





CHART 2: OVER-THE-YEAR CHANGE IN PRIVATE SECTOR JOBS

JANUARY 1991 - SEPTEMBER 2008




Note: The current private sector jobs series begins in January 1990; thus, over-the-year changes in the series start in January 1991.




CHART 4: LABOR FORCE STATISTICS IN SEPTEMBER 2008


...NYS unemployment rate remained the same




...NYS total unemployment increased
