


TAA Program Benefits by TA-W Number


One-Time Choice Election (80,000 and Above)


Implementation Timeline


Hypothetical Case: TA-W-80,700


2011 Program Benefits: TRA Timeline


Gilbert & Sullivan Scenario




Completion TRA

ATAA/RTAA ELIGIBILITY

WITH

a petition certification for TAA...

Eligible to apply for RTAA under 2009 program

WITH

a petition certification for TAA & ATAA but no TAA benefit or service by December 20, 2011...

Eligible to apply for RTAA under 2011 program

WITH

a petition certification for TAA...

Eligible to apply for RTAA under 2011 program

a petition certification for TAA and a negative determination for ATAA

Eligible to apply for RTAA under the 2011 program

a petition certification for TAA & ATAA and a qualifying TAA benefit or service by December 20, 2011

Election to continue with 2002 (ATAA) or choose RTAA/2011

receiving ATAA ...

Election to continue with ATAA/2002 or choose RTAA/ 2011

What happens if a participant is eligible for an election and you does not make a choice by March 19, 2012?

The participant will continue to receive benefits and services under the 2002 program.

What is a qualifying TAA benefit or service for election?

- Receipt of training waiver
- Receipt of TRA payment
- Receipt of ATAA payment
- Enrolled in or completed training
- Receipt of Job Search or Relocation Allowance
